

The Appalachian Farmacy is a USDA funded pilot Fruit & Vegetable Prescription project that launched in July 2017 in Washington County, TN. The program connects low-income patients at the Johnson City Community Health Center and members of the Johnson City and Jonesborough Senior Centers with vouchers to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables at local farmers markets.

The goal of Appalachian Farmacy is to increase the consumption of fresh fruits and vegetables by participating families and to increase their knowledge of cooking and nutrition.
